

Rio 2016 Qualification at the Baku 2015 European Games

(v.2.0 24.2.15)

12 of the 20 sports at the Baku 2015 European Games offer a variety of qualification opportunities for the Rio 2016 Olympic Games.

There are four different levels of qualification opportunities available.

1) Direct Rio 2016 Qualification:

Table Tennis

The winner of the men and women's singles events will receive automatic Olympic qualification.

Triathlon

The winner of the men and women's events will receive direct qualification for their NOCs.

Shooting

The winner in the 15 Olympic events will receive direct qualification for their NOCs.

2) Indirect Rio 2016 Qualification

The ranking points awarded at Baku 2015 are the equivalent of European Championship level included on the World Ranking List, which are used to re-allocate places in the Olympic qualification system.

Boxing Road to Rio

Three quota places per weight category at the Baku 2015 European Games will be awarded for the 2015 AIBA World Boxing Championships.

The Top Ranked Boxer(s) in each weight category of the 2015 AIBA World Boxing Championships will each obtain a quota place for the Rio 2016 Olympic Games.

Wrestling Road to Rio

Only wrestlers whose NOC takes part in Baku 2015 European Games are eligible to participate in the 1st phase of the Rio 2016 Qualification System which is the 2015 World Championship. The NOC must enter the same number of wrestlers per style and weight category in Baku 2015 as they wish to enter at the World Championships.
