C. Eligibility

Athlete Eligibility

Only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter (at all times) may participate in the European Games. For the sake of clarity, all athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter in force during the qualification period for the European Games up until the end of the period of the European Games.

Age Requirements

There is no age limit requirement for Volleyball at the Baku 2015 European Games.

Medical and Anti-Doping Requirements

To be eligible to participate in the Baku 2015 European Games, all athletes must satisfy the medical requirements according to the Medical Controls defined in Chapter 6 of the FIVB Sports Regulations.

To be eligible to participate in the Baku 2015 European Games, all athletes must comply with anti-doping controls in accordance with the FIVB Sports Regulations and WADA Anti-doping Rules.

Additional Confédération Européenne de Volleyball (CEV) Requirements

To be eligible to participate in the Baku 2015 European Games, all players must meet eligibility conditions laid down by the FIVB in Chapter 9 of the FIVB Sports Regulations.

D. Qualification Process

The qualification system allows for the participation of the best athletes through a fair and transparent process within the framework of the Olympic Charter.

The Host NOC is guaranteed the following allocation subject to meeting the eligibility requirements detailed in section C.

- 2 (4 Athletes) Teams in the Men's Beach Volleyball Event
- 1 (14 Athletes) Team in the Men's Indoor Volleyball Event
- 2 (4 Athletes) Teams in the Women's Beach Volleyball Event
- 1 (14 Athletes) Team in the Women's Indoor Volleyball Event

E. Confirmation process for Quota Places

BEGOC on behalf of the CEV will inform NOCs/NFs in writing on 1 January 2015 of the team quota places they have obtained.

Eligible NOCs must inform BEGOC and the CEV in writing by 15 January 2015 whether or not they intend to participate at the European Games.

By 30 January 2015 the CEV will reallocate all available quota places.

F. Reallocation of unused quota places

Should an NOC return an athlete quota place that has been obtained from the 2014 CEV Entry Ranking, the next best ranked National Federation, not yet qualified, will be allocated the athlete quota place. This process will be repeated until all places are allocated.

G. Qualification Timeline

30 January 2015	CEV to reallocate all unused quota places
1 May 2015	Deadline for BEGOC to receive entry forms submitted by the NOCs

H. 2016 Olympic Qualification

For the Baku 2015 European Games FIVB has awarded Beach Volleyball the same ranking points as the continental tour masters which will be used for Rio 2016 Olympic Qualification purposes.
