2. Maximum Number of Athletes per NOC

- A maximum of 12 NOCs may have a maximum of three (3) quota places per event. Other NOCs may have a maximum of two (2) quota places per event.
- The maximum of three (3) quota places will be allocated to the first 12 NOCs to have three (3) athletes eligible through the Qualification Process.

4. Type of Allocation of Quota Places

Athlete quota places will be allocated to the NOC if they belong to the group of Qualification places or Host country places. Universality places will be allocated to individuals to be validated by the relevant NOCs.

C. Eligibility

Athlete Eligibility

Only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter (at all times) may participate in the European Games. For the sake of clarity, all athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter in force during the qualification period for the European Games up until the end of the period of the European Games.

Age Requirements

All athletes participating in the Baku 2015 European Games must be born on/or before 31 December 1997.

Additional European Triathlon Union (ETU) Requirements

To be eligible to participate in the Baku 2015 European Games all athletes must meet one of the following requirements by 15 January 2015.

- Winning a quota place for their NOC at the 2014 European Championships
- Being on the ETU Points List
- Being on the ITU Points List

	Quota places 1 to 5 will be allocated to the NOCs of the top five (5) finishers.	
	If any of the NOCs of top five (5) finishers has already earned three (3) quota places, then, the next highest finishing athlete earns the quota for his/her NOC.	



	This process will continue until the five (5) quota places have been allocated, providing the athletes are within the 10% quality control cut-off time. Any remaining quota place(s) will be allocated according to the ETU Points List (see section below).

	Qualification Process:	
	Quota places 6 to 58 will be allocated to the NOCs of the highest ranked athletes on the ETU Points List as of 31 December 2014, respecting the maximum quota allocation per NOC per event.	
	Athletes who have already qualified quota places will not be considered for this process. If this list is exhausted, the ITU Points List will be used.

	The Host Country is guaranteed two (2) quota places namely places 59 and 60. These places will be allocated to the NOC of Azerbaijan only if the NOC has not earned any qualification places. If Azerbaijan has earned two quota places, places 59 and 60 will be reallocated through the ETU Points List. If Azerbaijan has earned one quota place, place 59 will be assigned to Azerbaijan and place 60 will be reallocated through the ETU Points List. The NOC host quota is subject to meeting the eligibility criteria listed above in section C.

	Universality quota places are subject to the eligibility criteria listed above.	



E. Confirmation process for Quota Places

BEGOC on behalf of the ETU will inform NOCs/NFs in writing on 30 January 2015 of the athlete quota places they have obtained at the Qualification Event.

Eligible NOCs must inform BEGOC and the ETU in writing by 15 February 2015 whether or not they will use the allocated quota places.

By 28 February 2015 the ETU will reallocate all available quota places.

F. Reallocation of unused quota places

Should an NOC return an athlete quota place that has been obtained through the qualification process the quota place will be reallocated through the ETU Points List. This process will be repeated until all places are allocated.

If at the end of the process, there are slots unused, ETU will be able to complete the quota places, by including more athletes, regardless of the NOC quota limit, and respecting the Eligibility Criteria.
