## January - December

- 9 OFI board meetings take place during the year.
- 8 Meetings of the OFI Committees including Governance, Audit and Risk, Commercial and Finance, HR, Communications.
- 6 Meetings of the OFI Athletes' Commission.
- €95,000 Paid in scholarships (team and individuals) to Tokyo pathway athletes.

€20,000 – Savings generated for member NGBs through FOC use of Olympic minibus.

**€200,000** – Paid to 19 Member Federations to support Olympic focused projects across the current cycle.

September 26	Unveiling of FBD Insurance as top tier Sponsor to the Olympic Federation of Ireland.
October 3	Second workshop for Athletes participating at Youth Olympic Games with Anti-Doping, Welfare, Integrity and Social media usage covered.
October 3-21	Participation at Youth Olympic Games in Buenos Aires. The team of 16 athletes from 9 sports won 1 silver and 2 bronze medals in individual events. The media campaign reach of 23 million was exceptional, at more than double the figure of the EYOF last July, which was already a strong result.
October 4	Initial contact made with Paris 2024 Olympic Games organisers to arrange a site visit in 2019.
October 5	Launch of New Leaders programme – a collaboration between the Finnish Olympic Committee, with the Olympic Federation of Ireland and the Lithuanian Olympic Committee being run through the EOC Gender Equality in Sport Commission.
